Now, enjoy exploring the story with the activities outlined below.



### explore it

- From which country does this story originate?
- How does the storyteller get the audience to participate in the story?
- Why do you think only one teller tells this story since both tellers from Eth-Noh-Tec tell the other stories?



#### think it

- Why does the farmer name his best friend Great Joy?
- What magical wish is given to the farmer by Great Joy?
- What makes the magical wish fail on the first try?
- What happens in this story when the farmer trusts that the ox can move the cart?



#### create it

- Pretend you have a new cat. Give your cat a name. Why do you give the cat this name?
- Make the sound that the farmer's best friend made to reveal it was not a human.
- Draw a picture of what the crowd threw at the farmer and the ox when the ox did not move the cart.
   Draw what the crowd threw when the ox was successful.



#### tell it

- Ask your parent or guardian about the meaning of your name and why you were given your name. Write or tell someone the story of how you got your name.
- Describe your best friend or favorite person. Explain why they are special to you.
